Notification of the Department of Business Development
Re: Prescription of Registration Number for a Juristic Person Established under Foreign
Law Submitting an Application for License or Certificate under the Foreign Business Act
B.E. 2542 (1999), B.E. 2556 (2013)

Reference is made to the Department of Business Development's prescription of registration number for a juristic person established under foreign law pursuant to the Notification of the Department of Business Development Re: Rules and Procedures for Prescribing Registration Numbers for Memorandum of Association, Registered Partnership, Limited Company, Public Limited Company, Chamber of Commerce, Trade Association and Juristic Person Established under a Foreign Law Subject to the Foreign Business Act B.E. 2542 (1999).

The Department of Business Development has conducted an inspection to revamp the registration numbering of juristic persons for the benefit of using such juristic person registration number for reference purposes. The inspection revealed that certain juristic persons established under foreign law which have received licenses or foreign business certificates have more than 1 juristic person registration number. Therefore, juristic persons established under foreign law are requested to perform the following:

- 1. inspect license or foreign business certificate in the name of the juristic person to determine whether there is more than 1 number;
- 2. in the case where more than 1 juristic person registration number is found, the juristic person shall contact the Department of Business Development at the Office of Foreign Business Management to correct the juristic person registration number.

This Notification shall come into force as from now onwards.
