Notification of the Department of Business Development
Re: Withdrawal and Disposal of Application for License and Foreign Business

Certificate B.E. 2546 (2003)*

Whereas it is expedient to prescribe guidelines for withdrawal and disposal of applications in the case of abandonment in regard to applications for licenses and foreign business certificates, as follows:

1. An application for license or foreign business certificate that has been submitted and pending consideration may be withdrawn by the submission of a written application to withdraw signed by the applicant of license or certificate.

Upon receiving such withdrawal application, the Foreign Business Registrar shall dispose of the application.

2. An application for license or certificate which appears to be incomplete and an official has already notified the applicant to correct the deficiency, if the applicant for license or certificate fails to complete the correction within 45 days of acknowledging the notice to correct such deficiency, it shall be deemed that the applicant abandons the application and the application shall be disposed.

This Notification shall come into force as from now onwards.
